Dr. Megan McKenna is an internationally recognized story teller. She has visited through North and South America, Europe, and a collection of islands including the Philippine islands. She works with indigenous groups, in base Christian communities, and with justice and peace groups. In 2002, she was appointed an Ambassador of Peace for *Pax Christi*. She is also an internationally known theologian, lecturer, and a gifted writer. She has more than 30 books to her name. Her latest publication includes *Like a Hammer Shattering Rock: Hearing the Gospels Today* and *The Light of Lent through the Gospels*, both published in 2013. In 2012, she was awarded the Isaac Hecher Award for Social Justice.
